HON'BLE VIVEK KUMAR SINGH, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. The present application has been filed by applicants for quashing the non-bailable warrant dated 29.6.2022 issued by Additional District and Session Judge, Court No. 3, Allahabad in S.T. No. 670 of 2019 (State vs. Vinod Kumar) arising out of Case Crime No. 140 of 2019, under Section 4/5 of Explosive Act, Police Station Cantt. District Prayagraj.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that applicant is ready to appear before the court concerned and on account of compelling circumstances, he could not appear on the date fixed before the court below therefore, as a result of the same, non bailable warrant dated 29.6.2022 has been issued against the applicant.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant undertakes to participate in the trial court's proceedings and he shall remain present before the court concerned unless the personal presence of the applicant is exempted by the court below. It is further submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant will cooperate in the trial court's proceedings.
5. On the other hand learned AGA submits that due to non appearance of the applicant on several dates, the leaned trial Court proceeded to issue

nonailable warrant against the applicant.

6. In view of the facts of the case, this Court deems it fit that nonailable warrant issued against the applicant shall be kept in abeyance for a period of four weeks and applicant shall appear before the court concerned within the time fixed by this Court. If, the applicant appears before the court concerned, nonailable warrant shall not be further executed. However, if the applicant fails to appear or participate in the trial proceeding within the time fixed by this Court, nonailable warrant shall be executed against the applicant without delay.

7. In view of the aforesaid, this application is disposed of.
