1. Supplementary affidavit, filed by learned counsel for the petitioners today in Court, is taken on record.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner no. 1 is a major girl aged about 25 years as noted in the F.I.R. itself. Learned counsel for the petitioners has next submitted that she, out of her own free-will and consent, had gone with the petitioner no. 2 and has already married with petitioner no.2 on 6.3.2026 and is now living peacefully with him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has next submitted that there is nothing on record to show that the petitioner no. 1 was forcibly taken away and compelled to marry with petitioner no. 2 and as such, prima facie no offence complained of, is disclosed against the petitioner no.2, and the impugned F.I.R is liable to be quashed.

5. Matter requires consideration.

6. Issue notice to respondent no. 4 returnable within four weeks.

7. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the said period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within

one week thereafter.

8. List on 6.7.2026.

9. Till then, the petitioners shall not be arrested in pursuance of the impugned F.I.R. dated 8.3.2026, arising out of case crime no. 129 of 2026, under sections 87, 352, 351(3) B.N.S., P.S. Sadar Bazar, District Saharanpur.
