1. Sri Shobhit Yadav, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Utkarsh Malviya, learned counsel for the informant and Sri Imran Khan, learned AGA, for the State, are present.

However, applicant is husband of the deceased but it reflects that during investigation he was protected by this Court but it further appears that after submission of charge sheet in spite of the order passed by this Court he did not appear before the court and after about more than a year he surrendered before the court concerned on 30.1.2026 and in the meantime, process under Section 84 BNSS was also issued against him and applicant did not explain his conduct in the instant bail application, therefore, learned AGA as well as learned counsel for the informant are directed to file detailed counter affidavit within two weeks.
3. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.
4. List this case in the week commencing 11.5.2026 in the category of daily cause list.
