1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the respondent no.3 is a matured lady, aged about 32 years as noted in the first information report itself.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has next submitted that the respondent no.3 has been consensual physical relations with the petitioner for the last several years, however subsequently, when he had refused to marry her, the impugned F.I.R. has maliciously been lodged against him, though, no offence is disclosed against him and as such, the impugned F.I.R. is liable to be quashed.
4. In view thereof, matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to the respondent no. 3 returnable within three weeks.
6. Steps be taken within a week.
7. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the same period.
8. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

9. Tag with Criminal Misc. Writ Petition No. 4005 of 2026 and list on 15.05.2026.

10. Till then, the petitioner shall not be arrested in pursuance of the impugned F.I.R. dated 07.02.2026 giving rise to Case Crime No. 0060 of 2026, under Sections 69, 115(2), 352, 351(3) of B.N.S., 2023, Police Station Meer Ganj, District Bareilly.
