1. Heard Sri Ajay Kumar Srivastava, learned counsel for applicants, Ms. Shivangi Bhargava, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned AGA for State.
2. At the very outset, Sri Ajay Kumar Srivastava, learned counsel for applicants submitted that both the parties have already been entered into a compromise on dated 16.03.2026 but the same has not been preferred before learned court concerned.
3. Learned counsel for both the parties are hereby requested to advice their clients i.e. applicant and opposite party nos. 2 to file compromise deed dated 16.03.2026 before learned court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sant Kabir Nagar/court concerned within 15 days from today.
4. In case, the said compromise deed is filed within the stipulated period, learned court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sant Kabir Nagar/court concerned shall verify the same in presence of both the parties within a period of four weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court through the Registry on or before the next date.
6. Registrar (Compliance) is hereby directed to serve a copy of this order upon learned court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sant Kabir Nagar/court concerned within **five working days** and after receiving verification report, same may be placed in record of this matter, so that the matter may be adjudicated on the basis of verification report.

7. List in week commencing 11.05.2026.

8. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be initiated against the applicant herein in pursuance to Case no. 4767 of 2007 (State vs. Ram Suresh) arising out of Case Crime no.717 of 2007, under Sections 323, 332, 353, 504, 506 of I.P.C. and Section 7 of Criminal Law Amendment Act, Police Station-Dhanghata, District-Sant Kabir Nagar which has not been disputed by Sri Manish Prajapati, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.
