Heard learned counsel for the revisionist on the point of admission.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the revisionist that in this case an F.I.R. was lodged against the revisionist with allegation that in a civil suit Amin Report was filed which contained three pages only, thereafter, the revisionist filed a Writ Petition No.26966 of 2021 before this Court by adding two extra pages after fabrication in the Amin Report. After investigation charge sheet was also filed by the I.O. which is pending before the learned court concerned. Further submitted that in Writ Petition No.26966 of 2021 the certified copy of Amin Report containing three pages was annexed and later on two other pages were filed those were related to the details of property in dispute but were not part of the Amin Report. On the basis of those extra two pages with Amin Report, under misconception the present F.I.R. was lodged by the informant. Learned trial court did not consider all these facts while deciding the application for discharge but passed the order in question dated 17.12.2025 erroneously and illegally. The learned counsel for the revisionist also attracted the attention of this Court towards the Amin Report filed with Writ Petition No.26966 of 2021 which contained three pages and two other pages are related to description of property but neither they are part of Amin Report nor there is signature of Amin.

In this way, the matter involves legal question.

As a result, this criminal revision is admitted.

Issue notice to the opposite party no.2 returnable within four weeks.

In the meantime, the operation of the order dated 17.12.2025 passed by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division)/Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate/Fast Track Court, Bhadohi in Criminal Case No.13041 of 2022 (State vs. Zubaida Begum and others) arising out of Case Crime No.82 of 2022, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B I.P.C., Police Station Gyanpur, District Bhadohi, shall remain stayed.
