1. Heard Mr. Punit Kumar, learned counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The instant application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and quash the entire proceeding of the Case No. 2719 of 2026 and Charge sheet dated 05.12.2025 (State v. Akshay and others) arising out of Case Crime No. 0249 of 2025, U/S 85, 115(2), 352, 351(2), BNS and 3/4 D.P Act, P.S Mahila Thana, District Muzaffarnagar, pending in the court of Civil Judge (Jr. Div), FTC-1, Muzaffarnagar.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court Allahabad, for amicable settlement of the dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- by way of demand draft/pay order in the name of Allahabad High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC), within a period of three weeks from today. Out of the same, Rs. 20,000/- be paid to opposite party No. 2 and Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties.

The Mediation Centre will submit its report in the matter within three months.

6. List on 07.07.2026 in the daily cause list before the appropriate Bench alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive measures be taken against the applicants.

8. In case, the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically be vacated.
