1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the respondent no. 4 is a major lady and she is alleged to be in consensual physical relations with the petitioner since 2024. However, subsequently, when the petitioner refused to marry her, impugned F.I.R. has maliciously been lodged against the petitioner, just with an intention to humiliate and harass him, though, no offence, complained of, is disclosed against the petitioner and as such, the impugned FIR qua the petitioner is liable to be quashed.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice to the respondent no.4, returnable within four weeks. Steps be taken within a week.
5. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the same period.
6. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.
7. List on 07.07.2026.
8. Till then, the petitioner shall not be arrested in pursuance of FIR dated 24.02.2026, arising out of Case Crime No. 0071 of 2026, under Section 69 BNS, Police Station Sipri Bazar, District Jhansi.
