1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that the present criminal revision has been filed with the relief which has been mention in the prayer clause. The prayer clause is delineated below:-

"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to allow the instant Revision and set aside the judgment and order dated 4.2.2026 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court No. 1 at Agra in Case No. 207 of 2018 (Smt.Rajni & another Vs. Vikash Singh) only in so far as it has provided for a payment of only Rs.7000/- per month as maintenance to the Revisionists, so that justice done.

It is further prayed that during the pendency of present Criminal Revision the operation of the impugned judgment and order dated 4.2.2026 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court No. 1 at Agra in Case No. 207 of 2018 (Smt. Rajni & another Vs. Vikash Singh) only in so far as It has provided for a payment of only Rs.7000/- per month as maintenance to the Revisionists be stayed so that justice be done such other and further orders may be passed as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that, vide interim order, a sum of Rs. 8,000/- was awarded as maintenance to the revisionist by the learned Family Court; however, in the final order, the said amount has been reduced to Rs. 7,000/- per month, despite the fact that the income of the opposite party (husband) is stated to be approximately Rs. 1,00,000/- per month.

4. Issue notice to the opposite party for filing counter affidavit within a period of four weeks from today. The revisionist may file rejoinder affidavit within one week, thereafter.

5. List this case on 13.5.2026 as fresh.
