1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants and learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the applicants has took the attention of this Court to page no. 11 of the rejoinder affidavit dated 19.08.2025 which is compromise filed but it has not been signed by all the accused.
3. On this, learned counsel for the applicants made a prayer that the applicants may be allowed to file fresh compromise duly signed by all the parties.

Looking to the nature of the case and the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicants, let the parties appear before the learned lower court within three weeks from today and file fresh compromise duly signed by all the parties. 6. Till the next date of listing, interim order, if any granted earlier, shall continue to operate.
