1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned AGA for the State respondents and Sri Ram Vilas Kanaujiya, who has filed his Vakalatnama today on behalf of the opposite party no. 2. His Vakalatnama is taken on record.
2. Present application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed for quashing the entire criminal proceeding and summoning order dated 15.12.2023 in Case No. 42 of 2023 (State vs. Ashish and others) arising out of Case Crime No. 439 of 2023, under Sections 420, 504, 506, 376 IPC, Police Station Bitia-2, District Gautam Budh Nagar pending before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gautam Budh Nagar.
3. It is contended by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant and opposite party no. 2 have entered into compromise and the same is annexed as Annexure-1 to the supplementary affidavit. It is, thus, submitted that a direction be issued to the office to send the compromise to the learned trial court for its verification.
4. On the other hand, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 as well as learned AGA have no objection to the aforesaid prayer.
5. In view of the above, the office is directed to send the compromise annexed as Annexure-1 to the supplementary affidavit to the concerned trial court for its verification.

6. The applicant and opposite party no. 2 are directed to appear before the trial Court on 11.5.2026.

7. Learned trial Court concerned shall verify the compromise and submit a report to this Court within two weeks thereafter.

8. Learned counsel for the applicant may also file supplementary affidavit bringing on record certified copy of the verification proceedings within the aforesaid period of two weeks.

9. Put up this case on 27.5.2026 as fresh.

10. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant pursuant to the aforesaid case.
