1. Heard Sri Arun Yadav, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Standing Counsel for the respondent nos. 1 to 5 and Sri Amit Kumar holding brief of Sri Bhupendra Kumar Tripathi for the respondent no. 6.
2. It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the main road connecting the Village Sihori, Tehsil Saidpur, District Ghazipur to the metaled road is filled with dirty water being flown from the houses and fields is causing inconvenience to the villagers in their free movement from the village due to water logging on the main road. The villagers are suffering from water borne diseases. Despite various representations having been made to the District Magistrate, no action has been taken for ensuring proper sanitation in the village.
3. In view of the aforesaid, learned Standing Counsel and learned counsel appearing for the respondent no. 6 Gram Panchayat Sihori are granted two weeks time to seek instructions in the matter.
4. List again as fresh on 24.04.2026.
