1. Heard Sri Diwas Verma, learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and to quash the entire criminal proceeding of Case Crime No. 22 of 2025 (State Vs. Siddharth Jain and others) including summoning order dated 27.1.2026 under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 of IPC Police Station - Moolganj, District East (Commissionerate Kanpur Nagar) pending before the court of learned Additional Civil Judge, Court No. 7, Kanpur Nagar and all consequential proceedings thereon.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad for the amicable settlement of the matrimonial dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order in the name of Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of four weeks from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 20,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no. 2 as legal expenses on her appearance before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties. The

Mediation Centre will submit its report within three months in the matter.

6. List this case on 07.07.2026 in the daily cause list alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. Till then no coercive measures shall be taken against the applicant.

8. In case, the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically be vacated.
