The statement of the prosecutrix under Section 180 BNSS has been recorded but not under Section 183 BNSS. This fact shows that so far as the prosecutrix is concerned, she has been recovered. The statement of the prosecutrix under Section 183 BNSS should have been recorded most promptly.

The Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ganganagar, District Prayagraj will ensure that the statement of the prosecutrix is recorded under Section 183 BNSS **within the next 48 hours.**

The statement made under Section 183 BNSS shall be produced before us in a sealed cover by the learned Judicial Magistrate concerned, whoever records it, on or before the next date scheduled.

The allegations against the petitioner who is a relative of the co-accused Atul who is said to have taken away the prosecutrix by blandishment is marginal. She is said to have assisted Atul.

Lay as fresh on 15.04.2026.

Until further orders of this Court, the petitioner **Anju** shall not be arrested in Case Crime No. 0048 of 2026, under Sections 137 (2) BNS (360 IPC), 87 BNS (366 IPC), 351 (2) BNS (506 IPC) and 352 BNS (504 IPC), Police Station Nawabganj District Ganganagar (Commissionerate Prayagraj).

Let this order be communicated to the Commissioner of Police Prayagraj the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ganganagar, District Prayagraj and the S.H.O., P.S. Nawabganj District Prayagraj through learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Prayagraj by the Registrar (Compliance) **today**.
