1. Heard Mr. Aman Kumar Shukla, holding brief of Ms. Aditi Srivastava, learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and quash the order dated 14-10-2025 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate/Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division) Court No. 2, Meerut as well as quash the entire proceedings of Criminal Case No. 2758 of 2020 (arising out of Crime No. 170 of 2019, Police Station-Mahila Thana, District-Meerut), State versus Ajay and another, under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 I.P.C and 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act pending in the court of Judicial Magistrate/Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division) Court No. 2, Meerut.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the matrimonial relationship between the applicant and the opposite party No. 2 has been dissolved through decree of divorce dated 29.11.2024 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Court No. 1, Meerut and no matrimonial relationship exists between the parties.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party No. 2, returnable at an early date.
6. Opposite parties may file counter affidavit within four weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within two weeks thereafter.
7. Connect and list this case on 21.07.2026 in the daily cause list along with the records of application u/s 482 Cr.P.C. No. 12299 of 2020 (Ajay and

Another Vs. State of U.P. and Another).

8. Until further orders, the proceedings in Criminal Case No. 2758 of 2020 (arising out of Crime No. 170 of 2019, Police Station-Mahila Thana, District-Meerut), State versus Ajay and another, under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 I.P.C and 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act shall remain in abeyance.
