HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. Shri Sandeep Kumar Yadav, Learned counsel for the informant has filed his Vakalatnama in the Court today and states that his instructions are incomplete.

2. Put up as fresh on 16.04.2026.

3. Till the next date of listing, in the event of arrest of the applicant-Guddi Devi, involved in the case crime No.72/2026 under Sections 85, 108, 352, 351(3) BNS and 3/4 D.P. Act, P.S. Barhalganj, District Gorakhpur, she shall be released on interim anticipatory bail on her furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station/Court concerned with the following conditions:-

(i) The applicant shall not tamper with evidence and that she would appear before the trial Court on the date fixed unless exempted by the Court concerned;

(ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) The applicant would co-operate during trial and would not misuse the liberty of bail.

(iv) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.

(v) The applicant shall not pressurize/intimidate the prosecution witness;

4. In default of any of the conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of interim anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.
