HON'BLE DEEPAK VERMA, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant; learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application has been filed to quash the impugned order dated 16.02.2026 passed by the Civil Judge (J.D)/F.T.C (Crime Against Women) in Complaint Case No.163 of 2024 (Laveena Khan Versus Rahul Ahmad), whereby the learned trial court has issued summons against the applicant under sections 498A and 323 I.P.C and 3/4 D.P. Act, pending before Civil Judge (J.D)/F.T.C (Crime Against Women) Mirzapur.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that instant complaint has been lodged by opposite party no.2 on account of some misconception. Now there is chances of settlement between the parties if the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre.
4. At present, prima facie, it does appear that the present criminal proceedings do arise out of the matrimonial dispute between the parties. Therefore, it further appears, if the parties were to be offered assistance of mediation, they may be able to resolve their differences and bring an end to all disputes and differences between them, amicably.
5. The matter is referred to the District Court, Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mirzapur with direction that the same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties.

6. It is directed that District Court, Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mirzapur shall proceed in the matter, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months and shall submit report thereafter.
7. List after expiry of aforesaid period before the appropriate Bench along with the report of District Court, Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mirzapur.
8. Till the next date of listing, proceeding of the aforesaid case against the applicant, shall remain stayed.
9. It is made clear that in case there occurs default by the applicant in appearing before the Mediation Centre on the date fixed, the interim order shall cease to operate. The District Court, Mediation & Conciliation Centre, Mirzapur, shall make a report in this regard to this Court, immediately.
