Heard Sri Aviral Agarwal, holding brief of Sri Ishir Sripat, learned counsel for the applicant.

Present transfer application has been filed, seeking transfer of Matrimonial Case No.2085 of 2025 (Sumit Saini vs. Kajal Saini) under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Meerut to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bulandshahr.

It is submitted that the marriage of the applicant was solemnized with the opposite party on 14.2.2024. Thereafter, the applicant was subjected to cruelty and harassment, and on 8.7.2025, the opposite party took the applicant to her parental home at Bulandshahr and left her there. The opposite party, since then has not maintained any contact with the applicant despite her best efforts.

Complaint Case No.98 of 2025 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and Matrimonial Case No.1308 of 2025 under Section 144 of BNSS are stated to be pending before the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bulandshahr. An FIR was also lodged by the applicant on 29.9.2025, which was registered as Case Crime No.0537 of 2025, pursuant to which investigation is still pending.

It is submitted that the applicant is presently living with her father, who is very old and, therefore, the applicant would face grave hardship in

contesting the proceedings at Meerut.

Accordingly, present application for transfer.

Matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to the opposite party, returnable by 12th May, 2026.

Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Matrimonial Case No.2085 of 2025 (Sumit Saini vs. Kajal Saini) under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Meerut, **shall remain in abeyance.**
