HON'BLE DR. GAUTAM CHOWDHARY, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the material brought on record.
2. The present application has been moved seeking anticipatory bail in Case Crime No. 1477 of 2025, under Sections 8, 18, 29 of N.D.P.S. Act, Police Station Baradari, District Bareilly, with the prayer that in the event of arrest, applicant may be released on anticipatory bail.
3. List and connect along with Criminal Misc. Anticipatory Bail Application u/s 482 BNSS No. 3053 of 2026 (Mintu Vs. State of U.P.).
4. As an interim measure, till the next date of listing, the applicant- Akash Sharma, is granted interim anticipatory bail in the aforesaid case crime, on furnishing a personal bond with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant shall attend the court proceedings as and when required.
 - (ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise or to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
 - (iii) The applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the court.

5. In case of breach of any of the above conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of interim anticipatory bail before this Court.
