1. Sri Gyan Prakash, learned Advocate, holding brief of Sri Mool Chandra Maurya, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Rajesh Kumar, learned counsel for the informant and Sri Imran Khan, learned AGA, for the State, are present.

2. At the very outset learned AGA pointed out that however, applicant is 'dever' of the deceased but in this case FIR was lodged on 31.10.2024 but applicant is in jail since 18.8.2025, therefore, he prima facie appears to be an absconder but in this regard no explanation has been given in the instant bail application.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant was not an absconder but he fairly conceded that this fact has not been disclosed by him in the instant bail application. He prays for and is granted one week time to file supplementary affidavit explaining the conduct of the applicant.

4. List this case on 22.4.2026 in the category of daily cause list **in top ten cases.**
