HON'BLE SAMEER JAIN, J.

1. Sri Suresh Dhar Dwivedi, learned counsel for the applicant and Sri Imran Khan, learned AGA, for the State, are present.
2. However, applicant is father-in-law of the deceased but from the record it reflects that earlier deceased herself lodged FIR under Section 498A IPC and Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act against him and his family members including her husband and it appears that FIR lodged by deceased has not been annexed along with the instant bail application, therefore, learned AGA is directed to file detailed counter affidavit within two weeks annexing entire material available on record including the FIR lodged by deceased against the applicant and his family members under Section 498A IPC and other Sections.
3. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.
4. List this case on 6.5.2026 amongst top ten cases in the category of daily cause list.
