Let the Superintendent of Police, Farrukhabad file her own affidavit answering the allegation in paragraph 10 of the writ petition within a week.

Lay as **fresh** on **28.04.2026**.

In addition, the point involved in this petition is that the power to investigate an offence involving the GST vests in the Commissioner of GST and his officers, as provided under the U.P. GST Act and the CGST Act.

The allegations are substantially ones relating to evasion of GST and deprivation of revenues to the State.

Till the next date of listing, the petitioner **Ashish Kumar** shall not be arrested in Case Crime No. 72 of 2026, under Sections 318 (4), 319 (2), 338, 336 (3), 340 (2), 61 (2) BNS, Police Station Kaimganj, District Farrukhabad.

Let this order be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Farrukhabad and the S.H.O., P.S. Kaimganj, District Farrukhabad through the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Farrukhabad by the Registrar (Compliance) within **48 hours next**.
