**HON'BLE VINOD DIWAKAR, J.**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had availed a Kisan Credit Loan of Rs. 1,10,000/- from respondent no.4, i.e., Indian Bank, Branch Pakadia Naugawa, bearing Account No. 7779685895, for the purpose of sowing sugarcane and other crops, from which an anticipated yield of approximately Rs. 5,20,000/- was expected. It is further submitted that due to natural calamity, the petitioner's agricultural land was submerged in river water, resulting in complete destruction of the standing crops, thereby rendering the petitioner incapable of repaying the loan amount within the stipulated time.
2. Shri Amrish Sahai, learned counsel appearing for respondent no.4, prays for and is granted four weeks' time to place on record the agreement executed between the petitioner and the bank at the time of availing the Kisan Credit Card (KCC) loan, particularly the terms and conditions governing the disbursement of the loan amount.
3. Shri Krishna Kant Shukla, learned counsel for the Union of India is present.
4. Put up on 26.5.2026 as fresh.
