HON'BLE ROHIT RANJAN AGARWAL, J.

1. The writ petition filed by the applicant as well as other connected matters was decided on the basis of consent given by counsel for the parties in the said writ petition on 20.03.2023.
2. From the order, it is clear that the payment was to be made to applicant by competent authorities of the State Government as well as ICAR, New Delhi. Both the parties were to bear 50% of arrears to be paid to the applicant and the other similarly placed persons. When the order of writ Court was not complied, the present contempt proceedings were initiated.
3. Today, when the matter was taken up, Sri Rakesh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for University authorities submitted that in view of decision rendered by Lucknow Bench on 03.03.2023 in Writ-A No. 2071 of 2023, the applicant as well as other similarly placed persons are not entitled for arrears of 7th PRC and the 7th PRC has to be paid to only those teachers who were initially appointed on the duly created post of teachers in the University. Sri Rakesh Kumar, thereafter, submitted that a review application has been preferred which is pending consideration.
4. Learned counsel for the applicant has apprised that writ Court has released the matter and the matter has been nominated to another Bench.
5. Ms. Sumati Rani Gupta, learned counsel appearing for opposite party no. 2 submits that 50% of arrears which was required to be paid by ICAR

has already been released from their end and the order has been complied by opposite party no. 2 and it is the university authorities who have to release their part and make payment to the applicant.

6. This Court finds that order of writ Court is of the year 2023 and more than 3 years have elapsed since passing of the order but it has not been complied till date.

7. As a last opportunity, the Vice-Chancellor, Chandra Shekhar Azad University Agriculture and Technology, Kanpur is hereby directed to comply the order of writ Court. In case of non-compliance, the present incumbent Vice-Chancellor shall remain present in the Court on 20.05.2026 for framing of charge.

8. List this matter on 20.05.2026.
