1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist as well as learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present criminal revision has been filed with a prayer to allow the revision and modify the impugned judgment & order dated 19.4.2025 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court No.2, Firozabad in Criminal Case No. 1470 of 2024 (Smt. Madhu Devi Vs. Kuldeep) under Section 125 Cr.P.C., Police Station Pachokhara, District Firozabad.
3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that in this case the revisionist is wife and the opposite party is husband and the matter is related to matrimonial dispute and the revisionist has intention to settle the same amicably. Learned counsel further urged that this case may be referred to the Mediation Centre of this Court so that they may have a chance to settle their dispute on their own terms through mediation.
4. The Court is also satisfied on the basis of the record and the submissions made before it that the nature of litigation is such that there is a chance to resolve the matter through process of mediation and an attempt ought to be made to explore that possibility.
5. Accordingly, the matter is being referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad.
6. The revisionist will deposit Rs. 5,000/- within 30 days from today at the Mediation Centre through demand draft, which will remain deposited with the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad as expenses.
7. The mediator is allowed three months' time to find out possible solution of the dispute between the parties and send his report to the court regarding the outcome of mediation.

8. Put up this matter after three months in the additional cause list before the appropriate Bench along with report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

9. This case shall not be treated as tied up or part heard with this Bench.
