1. List has been revised. No one appears on behalf of the revisionist.
2. Learned counsel for the private opposite party no. 2 as well as learned A.G.A. for the State are present.
3. Counter affidavit has already been filed on behalf of the opposite party no. 2 and in para-9 of the counter affidavit, he submits that revisionist has not paid a single penny in compliance of the order of this Court till date.
4. This Court vide order dated 15.10.2024, directed the revisionist to continue to pay the opposite party no. 2 maintenance to the tune of Rs. 4000/- per month as per the terms and conditions of the impugned order dated 02.03.2024. Therefore, prima facie, it appears that the revisionist has not complied with the order dated 15.10.2025.
5. However, a last opportunity is given to the revisionist to pay total amount due towards to him in compliance of the order dated 15.10.2025, within four weeks from today.
6. In case of failure of revisionist, to pay the aforesaid arrears of maintenance amount, which is due in compliance of order dated 15.10.2025, within four weeks from today, the interim relief granted for payment of Rs. 4,000/- per month instead of Rs.5000/- per month, shall automatically stand vacated.
7. List this case on **28.04.2026**.
