Shri Krishna Datta Tiwari, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order of the Settlement Officer Consolidation was adverse to the petitioner and the same was passed without noticing the petitioner or affording any opportunity of hearing to him. A specific ground was taken to this effect in the memo of revision. The revising court/Deputy Director of Consolidation while passing the impugned order has neglected to return any finding on the aforesaid issue.

Matter needs consideration.

Issue notice to private respondents No. 4 and 5 by RPAD as well as regular process, returnable within a period of four weeks. Steps to be taken within a period of two weeks.

Respondents to file counter affidavit by the next date of listing.

List thereafter.

The effect and operation of the impugned order dated 09.06.2025 passed by the respondent No. 1 in revision No.

0006 of 2025 (Indresh vs. Updesh Tyagi and others) as well as the order dated 19.12.2024 passed by the respondent No. 2 in appeal No. 169 (updesh Tyagi vs. Jagesh and others) and appeal No. 168 (Smt. Sudesh Devi vs. Jagesh and others) shall remain stayed till the next date of listing.
