1. On 26.3.2026, following order was passed by this Court:-

*"1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Standing Counsel for the State-respondents.*

*2. The instant writ petition has already been entertained and notice was issued to other private respondents except respondent no.2, who was represented by Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Yadav, learned counsel, accordingly, steps were taken by learned counsel for the petitioners.*

3. Until further orders of this Court, the parties are directed to maintain status quo with respect to nature and possession of the plot in question.
