1. Heard learned counsel for applicant and learned counsel appearing on behalf of opposite party no.2 as well as learned AGA for the State.
2. The present application has been preferred for seeking quashing of order dated 05.04.2025 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banda in Misc. Case No.04/11/2024, CNR No.UPBD040001792024 (Omprakash Gupta Vs. Mukeem Ahmad Khan), arising out of Case Crime No.190 of 2023, under Section 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC, P.S. Matoundh, District Banda, pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banda.
3. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for applicants submitted upon instructions so received by his clients/applicants that applicants are ready to pay the amount which has been spent by opposite party no.2 for his medical treatment. Upon instructions, it has also been stated by learned counsel for applicants that the criminal proceedings which have been initiated by applicants against opposite party no.2 shall also be withdrawn by applicants.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of opposite party no.2 is also ready to settle the dispute if the amount which has been spent by opposite party no.2 for his medical treatment, is paid by applicants as well as criminal proceedings which have been initiated by applicants against opposite party no.2 is withdrawn.
5. In view of the statements so made by learned counsel for parties upon instructions so received by their respective clients, applicants are directed to pay Rs.20,000/- to opposite party no.2 through online/demand draft/cheque

within four weeks from today and receiving of the same, shall be produced by learned counsel for applicants before this Court on the next date.

6. Put up this case on **22.01.2026 as fresh.**

7. This matter is tied up with this Bench since amicable settlement has already been arrived at the behest of both the parties and final order in respect of the same, will be passed on the next date fixed
