1. This application has been moved on behalf of the applicant - **Sarika Sharma** seeking anticipatory bail in Case Crime No. 562 of 2024, under Sections 61(2), 316(5) of BNS, P.S. Dhampur, District Bijnor.
2. Heard learned counsel for the applicant as well as the learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
3. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that applicant is innocent and she has apprehension of arrest in the above-mentioned case, whereas there is no credible evidence against her. Allegations levelled against the applicant are false. Since both the colleges involved in this matter are self-financed institutions, no government aid is provided to them and the provisions of Section 316(5) of BNS are not attracted in this matter. Applicant is a lady. There is no documentary evidence at all that she was drawing salary from both colleges simultaneously. It is further submitted that in case applicant is granted anticipatory bail, she will not misuse the liberty of bail and will co-operate in the proceedings of the Court / investigation and would obey all conditions of bail.
4. Learned A.G.A. opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that the applicant was taking salary from two colleges simultaneously. Alleged offences are fully made out against the applicant.

5. Matter requires consideration.

6. As requested, learned AGA is allowed three weeks' time to file counter affidavit. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within a week thereafter.

7. As an interim measure, till the next date of listing, the applicant is granted interim anticipatory bail in the aforesaid case crime number. In the event of arrest of the applicant, she shall be released on anticipatory bail on her furnishing a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the S.H.O. of the police station concerned with the following conditions:-

(i) The applicant shall make herself available before the police officer / I.O. as and when required.

(ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police office.

(iii) The applicant shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court and if she has passport, the same shall be deposited by her before the S.S.P./S.P. Concerned.

8. In case of default of any of the conditions, it will be a ground for cancellation of interim protection granted to the applicant.

9. List this case on **9.2.2025** before the appropriate Bench.

10. Assignment, if any, stands discharged.
