HON'BLE MADAN PAL SINGH, J.

1. Heard Mr. Ravindra Pratap Singh, learned counsel for the revisionist, Mr. Rahul Kumar Sharma, learned counsel for opposite party no.2 and the learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.
2. This criminal revision under Section 397/401 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the revisionist to set aside/quash the judgment and order dated 19th April, 2024 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Hathras, Case No. 307 of 2019 (Smt. Varsha Vs. Karan Singh), under Section 125 Cr.P.C., whereby the Principal Judge has allowed the application made by opposite party no.2 under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and directed the revisionist to pay Rs. 4,000/- per month to his wife i.e. opposite party no.2 as maintenance allowance from the date of filing of the instant application.
3. From the perusal of the record, it appears that the revisionist is the husband of opposite party No. 2.
4. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that the dispute between the parties is a matrimonial dispute and in case the matter is referred for mediation, the parties may get an opportunity to amicably settle their dispute. He, therefore, submits that in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, it will be in the interest of both the parties that the parties may be referred for mediation to the Mediation Centre, High Court, Allahabad.
5. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The revisionist is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 55,000/- by way of demand draft / pay order in the name of Registrar General A/c, Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre within a period of three weeks from today. After deposit of the aforesaid money, office shall send a notice to the opposite party no.2 calling upon her to file counter affidavit. Out of Rs.

55,000/-, Rs. 50,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no.2 on her appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The Mediation Centre will submit its report in the matter within three months.

6. List this case after four months alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. Till the next date of listing, effect and operation of the judgment and order dated 19th April, 2024 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Hathras, Case No. 307 of 2019 (Smt. Varsha Vs. Karan Singh), under Section 125 Cr.P.C., shall remain stayed provided the revisionist shall pay Rs.4,000/- per month to opposite party no.2 regularly towards monthly maintenance allowance .

8. If the amount, as directed above, is not deposited by the applicant within the aforesaid period, the stay order shall automatically come to an end and the office shall immediately list this case for further orders before the Court.
