1. Heard Shri Vikash Rastogi, Advocate holding brief of Shri Pramod Kumar Shukla, learned counsel for the applicant, Shri Dileep Singh Yadav, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. Today, learned counsel for the applicant has handed over the education certificates, 4 in number, i.e. High School, Intermediate, B.A. and M.A., to the learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant and opposite party no. 2 that the parties are husband and wife and there is likelihood of amicable settlement between the parties with the assistance of the mediation, therefore instant application may be referred to the Mediation Center to explore the possibility of re-conciliation between the parties.
4. It is directed that applicant shall deposit a sum of Rs.15,000/- within two weeks from today with the Mediation Centre of which 50% shall be paid to the opposite party no.2 for appearance before the Mediation Centre.
5. Upon deposit of the said amount, Mediation Centre shall issue notice to the parties fixing a date for their appearance before the Mediation Centre. Thereafter, Mediation Centre shall find out possible solution of the dispute between the parties.
6. It is directed that Mediation Centre shall send its report to the Court, expeditiously preferably within a period of two months. Thereafter, the case shall be listed before appropriate Bench on **24th April, 2026**.

6. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Case No. 76686 of 2024 (State Vs. Shailendra Kumar Yadav), arising out of Case Crime No. 595 of 2023, under Section 386 I.P.C., Police Station- Chakeri, District Kanpur Nagar, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kanpur Nagar, shall remain stayed against the applicant.

7. After depositing the amount aforesaid, notice shall be issued to the parties and in case the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically stands vacated.
