Heard Mr. Sanjay Kumar Dubey, learned counsel for the applicants, learned AGA on behalf of the State, Mr. Sanjay Kumar Srivastava, learned counsel for opposite party no.2 and perused the record.

This application u/s 528 BNSS has been filed by the applicants with the prayer to quash charge-sheet dated 29.08.2024, cognizance order dated 03.05.2025 as well as entire proceedings of Case No. 1086 of 2025 (State of U.P. Vs. Narayan Dutt Pathak and others), arising out of Case Crime No. 46 of 2024, under Sections 447 IPC, Police Station Sakrali, District Etah, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate/Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Jalesar, District Etah.

Learned counsel for opposite party no.2 prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file a counter affidavit.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the dispute between the parties is essentially civil in nature and there is a dispute with regard to boundary of an agricultural land. It is further submitted that the FIR has been lodged on false and concocted fact.

Learned counsel for the applicants next submits that bailable warrants have been issued against the applicants by the concerned court, therefore, it is prayed that some protection be granted to them, in case, this case is adjourned.
