1. Heard Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned counsel for applicant, Sri Rana Pratap Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned AGA for State.

2. At the very outset, Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned counsel for applicant submitted that both the parties have already been entered into a compromise on dated 10.09.2025 but the same has not been preferred before learned court concerned. This fact has been seconded by Sri Rana Pratap Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.

4. Learned counsel for both the parties are hereby directed to advice their clients i.e. applicants and opposite party nos. 2 to file compromise deed dated 10.09.2025 before learned court of Judicial Magistrate/FTC (Senior Division), Azamgarh within 15 days from today.

5. In case, the said compromise deed is filed within the stipulated period, learned court of Judicial Magistrate/FTC (Senior Division), Azamgarh shall verify the same in presence of both the parties within a period of four weeks thereafter and send its report to this Court through the Registry on or before the next date.

6. List this case in week commencing 24.11.2025 along with said report.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be initiated against the applicant in pursuance to chargesheet dated 22.08.2022 under Sections 307, 325, 342, 504, 506 IPC Police Station Raunapar, District Azamgarh arising out of Case crime no.0054 of 2022 as well as cognizance order dated 09.11.2022, pending before Judicial Magistrate/FTC (Senior Division), Azamgarh with Case no.15366 of 2022 (State vs. Aniket Singh) which has not been objected by Sri

Rana Pratap Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.

8. Registrar (Compliance) is hereby directed to serve a copy of this order upon learned court of Judicial Magistrate/FTC (Senior Division), Azamgarh within 48 hours and after receiving verification report, same may be placed in record of this matter, so that the matter may be adjudicated on the basis of verification report.
