1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for applicant that applicant is maternal uncle of the husband of opposite party no. 2 and there was some matrimonial dispute between opposite party no. 2 and her husband and in-laws. The allegation that applicant has outraged modesty of opposite party no. 2 is wholly improbable. At the time of incident, other family members were shown present in the house and thus, such an incident is not probable. Referring to the facts of the matter, it was submitted that impugned proceedings are malicious and thus, liable to be quashed.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice to opposite party no.2 returnable at an early date.
5. Opposite party no. 2 may file counter affidavit within four weeks.
6. List on 01.04.2025.
7. It is directed that till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant, namely, **Ram Vilash** in Complaint Case No. 963 of 2023 (Ruchi Vs. Ram Vilash), under Sections - 354, 323 I.P.C., Police Station -Indargarh, District - Kannauj, pending in the court of Civil Judge (S.D.) / Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kannauj.
