1. Heard learned counsel for applicants and learned AGA for State.
2. This application under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (*hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'*) has been filed for quashing of entire proceedings, including charge-sheet no.65 of 2022 dated 19.02.2022, of Session Trial No.999/2025 (State Vs. Uttam and others), arising out of Case Crime No.0746 of 2021, under Sections 452, 323, 504, 307 I.P.C., Police Station -Baghpat, District- Baghpat, pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Baghpat, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for applicants that matter relates to private dispute between the parties and both the parties have amicably settled the dispute and compromised the matter hence, the impugned proceedings may be quashed on the basis of compromise.
4. Whether a compromise has taken place or not can best be ascertained by the court where the proceedings are pending, after ensuring the presence of the parties before it.
5. In view of aforesaid, it is directed that in case both the parties appear before the court concerned and file an appropriate application for compromise within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be verified by the court concerned in accordance with law and if the said compromise is verified, a report to that effect will be prepared and the same shall be made part of the record and the parties would be allowed to obtain certified copy thereof and file the same before this Court by the next date. In case such compromise is verified, the court concerned shall also send the report of verification to this Court.

6. List this case on 10.11.2025.

7. It is directed that till the next date of listing, no coercive action would be taken against applicants in the aforesaid case.
