1. The instant writ petition has been filed with the following main reliefs:-

"(i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of CERTIORARI directing the respondent no.2 to produce the order of rejection mentioned in the consequential order dated 30.10.2024 issued by the respondent no.3 and quash the same and also quash the consequential order dated 30.10.2024 passed by respondent no.3.

(ii) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of MANDAMUS commanding/ directing the respondent no.2 to correct the date of birth of the petitioner in the High School Mark sheet i.e. Roll No.25194900 of the Secondary School Examination, 2024 as 03.07.2010 in place of 19.05.2009, within specified period as stipulated by this Hon'ble Court.

(iii) Issue any other or further writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

(iv) Award the cost of the writ petition to the petitioner."

2. Heard Shri Kulveer Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, perused the contents made in the writ petition and documents on record.

3. Taking into consideration of the submissions and contents made in the writ petition, I am of the view that matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice to respondent no.4 by ordinary post as well as registered post on payment of PF within a week. *Dasti* notice may also be issued.

5. The petitioner is directed to file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

6. Sri Santosh Kumar, learned Standing Counsel appeared on advance accepted notice on behalf of State-respondent no.1.

7. Sri Ashish Malhotra, learned counsel appeared on advance notice on behalf of respondent nos.2 and 3 vehemently opposed the petition and prayed for four weeks' time to file counter affidavit.
8. Let him file counter affidavit within four weeks.
9. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks, thereafter.
10. List this case on 06.11.2025.
