1. Heard Sri Dhirendra Kumar Srivastava, learned counsel for the applicant and Ms. Kirti Singh, learned A.G.A. for the State.

2. The instant application under section 582 BNSS has been filed seeking quashing of the summoning order dated 26.2.2020, charge sheet dated 23.1.2020 as well as the entire criminal proceedings of Criminal Case No. 292 of 2020 arising out of Case Crime No. 178 of 2019 under section 498A IPC and 3/4 of D.P. Act police station Gohan District Jalaun pending before the court of Judicial Magistrate, Jalaun.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant no. 1 and the opposite party no. 2 are husband and wife. There was some matrimonial discord between them due to which the instant case has been lodged by the opposite party no 2 against the applicants herein. Learned counsel for applicant submits that if an opportunity is granted to the parties there is a possibility of amicable settlement of dispute through the mediation centre of this Court.

4. Learned counsels for the parties admit that there are chances of reconciliation between the parties.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant case is referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court subject to deposit of a sum of Rs. 5,000/- by the applicant by way of demand draft / pay order in the name of Registrar General A/c, Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre within a period of two weeks from today. After deposit of the aforesaid amount, the Mediation Centre shall send a notice to the opposite party no.2 fixing 18.11.2025 to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on the date fixed in the notice. Out of aforesaid amount, a sum of Rs. 20,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no.2 on his first appearance, Rs. 15,000/- on his second appearance and Rs. 15,000/- on his third

appearance or final settlement, whichever is earlier before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The balance amount of Rs. 5,000/- shall be retained by the Mediation Centre towards cost of Mediation. The Mediation Centre shall submit its report in the matter within three months.

7. List this case on **19.2.2026** before the appropriate Bench.

8. In view of the fact as noted above and that the matter has been referred for mediation at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad, as an interim measure it is provided that no coercive action shall be taken against applicant in the aforesaid case from the date of deposit of amount as directed herein above till the next date of listing.

9. However, it is provided that if the amount, as directed above, is not deposited by the applicant within the aforesaid period, the protection granted to the applicant shall automatically stand vacated and the instant application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. shall stand dismissed, without any further reference to the Court.

10. If the mediation is successful and amount is determined to be paid to the opposite party no. 2, the amount paid by the applicants pursuant to this order shall be adjusted in the said amount.
