1. Heard Sri Atul Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Tarun Gaur, learned Standing Counsel for the State respondents.
2. This Court vide its order dated 12.11.2025 directed the petitioner to bring on record the schedule prepared in support of the impugned order dated 30.05.2025.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner files a supplementary affidavit today, which is taken on record.
4. This petition is being filed for a direction to quash the impugned order dated 30.05.2025 passed by the Deputy Director of Consolidation, Siddharth Nagar and also to quash the impugned order dated 07.05.2025 passed by the Consolidation Officer, Siddharth Nagar as well as also with a prayer to issue a direction in the nature of mandamus directing the concerned respondents to decide the matter as fresh after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
5. Main grievance of the petitioner is that the impugned order was passed without following the provisions of Section 48(3) of the Uttar Pradesh Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1953, which is mainly the compliance of the principles of natural justice.
6. Learned Standing Counsel prays for and is granted three weeks' time to obtain instructions in the matter.
