1. Heard Sri Vijay Prakash Singh Kushwaha, learned counsel for the applicants and Ms. Harshita Rani, learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. Challenge in this application under Section 528 BNSS is to the summoning order dated 08.07.2025 in Criminal Case No.134/9/2025 arising out of Case Crime No. 17 of 2024, under Sections 85, 11592) B.N.S. and under Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act, Police Station- Mahila Police Paramarsh Kendra Ganjdundwara, District Kasganj.
3. Learned counsel for applicants submits that the applicant no.1 is the husband of opposite party no.2. There was a matrimonial discord between the applicant no.1 and the opposite party no.2, due to which the instant FIR was lodged by the opposite party no.2 against the applicants. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that if an opportunity is granted to the parties, there is a possibility of amicable settlement of entire matrimonial dispute between the parties if the matter is sent to mediation centre of this Court.
4. Learned counsels for the parties admit that there are chances of reconciliation between the parties.
5. In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant case is referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court subject to deposit of a sum of Rs.35,000/- by the applicants by way of demand draft / pay order in the name of Registrar General A/c, Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre within a period of two weeks from today. After deposit of the aforesaid amount, the Mediation Centre shall send a notice to the opposite party no.2 fixing 13.11.2025 to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on the date fixed in the notice. Out of aforesaid amount, a sum of Rs. 10,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no.2 on her first appearance, Rs. 10,000/- on her second

appearance and Rs.10,000/- on her third appearance or final settlement, whichever is earlier before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The balance amount of Rs. 5,000/- shall be retained by the Mediation Centre towards cost of Mediation. The Mediation Centre shall submit its report in the matter within three months.

7. List this case on 06.02.2026 before the appropriate Bench.

8. In view of the fact as noted above and that the matter has been referred for mediation at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad, as an interim measure it is provided that no coercive action shall be taken against applicants till the next date of listing, from the date of deposit of amount as directed herein above.

9. However, it is provided that if the amount, as directed above, is not deposited by the applicants within the aforesaid period, the protection granted to the applicants shall automatically stand vacated and the instant application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. shall stand dismissed, without any further reference to the Court.
