1. Heard Sri P.K. Dwivedi, learned counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.A. for the State as well as Shri A.C. Srivastava, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 and perused the record.

2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and to quash the cognizance/summoning order dated 02.05.2025 and charge sheet dated 05.03.2025 as well as entire criminal proceedings of Criminal Case No. 1738 of 2025 (State of U.P. versus Aman Pratap alias Anshul & Others) arising out of Case Crime No. 0002 of 2024 under Sections 498-A, 323, 504, 506 of I.P.C. & Section 3/4 of D.P. Act, Police Station-Crossing Republic, District-Ghaziabad pending in the court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Court No. 02, Ghaziabad.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants states that the applicants consent to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad for the amicable settlement of the matrimonial dispute.

4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant no.1 is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order in the name of Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of four weeks from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 20,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no. 2 as legal expenses on her appearance before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre.

5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties. The Mediation Centre will submit its report within three months in the matter.
6. List this case on 07.07.2026 in the daily cause list alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.
7. Till then no coercive measures shall be taken against the applicants.
8. In case, the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically be vacated.
