HON'BLE DEEPAK VERMA, J.

1. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant, who is the husband of opposite party no. 2 has compromised the matter with opposite party no. 2 but present application u/s 528 B.N.S.S. is not supported by any compromise deed. He next submits that Application Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has been allowed on account of compromise, therefore, present criminal proceedings be quashed.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant is granted three weeks' time to file compromise deed entered between the parties.
3. Put up this case as fresh after three weeks.
