However, notice was issued to the informant on 10.11.2025 and till date service report is still awaited but Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned Brief Holder for the State apprised the Court that State received the notice of instant bail application on 16.10.2025 and as per his instructions notice has been served upon informant on 18.10.2025, therefore, it appears, despite service of notice none appeared on behalf of informant.
2. Ms. Reena Pal, learned counsel for informant and Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned Brief Holder for the State are present.
3. Considering the fact that as per statement of victim recorded under Section 183 BNSS it is case of gang rape, learned AGA is directed to file counter affidavit within two weeks. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed by the applicant within a week thereafter.
