HON'BLE ABDUL SHAHID, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist.
2. Notice has been served upon opposite party No. 2, but none appears on behalf of opposite party No. 2.
3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that the revisionist is not named in the F.I.R. The kidnapped girl has already been recovered. The revisionist is merely a driver and has no role in the alleged offence. It is further specifically submitted that even the statement of the alleged kidnapped girl has not been recorded by the Investigating Officer (I.O.).
4. Learned A.G.A. has relied upon Annexure No. 3. The arrested accused, Reshma alias Manisha, in her statement, stated that Anurag (Mobile No. 7526083060), Anurag Singh (owner of the hotel), Shreya Shukla, and Muskan were conducting human trafficking in collusion with each other. It is alleged that all of them were working for Anurag Singh and Anirudh Ojha. The name of the revisionist surfaced during the course of investigation. After due investigation, a charge sheet has been filed against the revisionist under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 9 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act.
5. The questions raised by learned counsel for the revisionist cannot be meticulously examined at this stage. The charge sheet has already been filed against the revisionist under the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act. The impact of any witness who has not been examined is a matter to be considered at the stage of trial.
6. There is sufficient material on record for framing of charges against the

revisionist. There is neither any illegality nor irregularity in the impugned order.

7. Accordingly, the criminal revision is liable to be dismissed and is hereby dismissed.
