1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned AGA for the State.
2. This application has been filed by applicant for quashing the impugned summoning order dated 13.12.2024 passed by Special Judge (N.D.P.S. Act)/Additional Session Judge, Court No.14, Agra in Complaint Case No. 6/25 of 2024 (State Vs. Vijay Goyal @ Bunti and others), under Sections 17B, 18A(I), 18(C), 18A, 27(B)(I) 27(C), 27B(II), 27(B), 28 N.D.P.S. Act, Police Station Sikandra, District Agra, pending before the court of Special Judge (N.D.P.S. Act)/Additional Session Judge, Court No. 14, Agra.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that applicant has been summoned under Sections 17B, 18A(I), 18(C), 18A, 27(B)(I) 27(C), 27B(II), 27(B), 28 N.D.P.S. Act. Learned counsel for the applicant has relied upon the complaint filed by the Drug Inspector, which is annexed at page no. 24 of the paper book which has been filed under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, however, summons have been issued under the NDPS Act. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that summoning order is bad in law.
4. Learned A.G.A. prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file obtain instructions in the matter.
5. List this case on 2.12.2025 as fresh.
