1. Heard Sri Ranjeet Yadav, learned counsel for the applicants and Sri Rakesh Kumar Gupta, learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. This application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking quashing of the summoning order dated 31.05.2024 passed in Complaint Case No. 1883 of 2023 under Sections 323, 504, 506, 452 I.P.C., Police Station- Rampur, District- Jaunpur, pending in the court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Vth, Jaunpur.
3. Learned counsel of the applicants submits that the applicant no.1 has lodged an F.I.R. against the sons of the opposite party no.2 and others for demolition of his house. As a counterblast to the said F.I.R. lodged by applicant no.1, the instant complaint case has been filed on 07.07.2022 by the opposite party no.2, wherein it is alleged that all the eleven accused persons, which includes the entire family members of the applicants have entered the house of the opposite party no. 2, abused and assaulted her and also snatched her gold chain. By implicating the entire family members a false complaint has been lodged by the opposite party no.2, that too as a counterblast, therefore, he seeks quashing of the entire proceedings against the applicants.
4. In view of the aforesaid submissions, matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite no.2.
6. Opposite parties shall file counter affidavit within four weeks.

7. Applicants shall have two weeks thereafter to file rejoinder affidavit.

8. List this matter on **09.09.2025** in **daily cause list**.

9. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicant herein.
