1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 and learned A.G.A. for the State.

2. The present 528 B.N.S.S. application has been filed to quash the charge-sheet No.03 dated 19.06.2023, cognizance/summoning order dated 05.08.2023 and cognizance/summoning order dated 25.01.2023 and charge-sheet no.02 dated 24.10.2022, order dated 29.09.2025 passed by the Civil Judge (J.D.)/F.T.C.-1/Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad, as well as entire proceedings of Case No.65596 of 2023 (State vs.Devesh Panchal and others) arising out of Case Crime No.0101 of 2022, under sections 498A, 323, 406, 506 I.P.C. & Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act, Police Station Mahila Thana, District Ghaziabad, pending before the court of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/F.T.C.-1 (Crime against Women), Ghaziabad, on the basis of compromise dated 20.02.2025.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicant no.1 is husband of opposite party no.2. Applicants and opposite party no.2 have settled their dispute out of Court and living separately. Divorce petition has also been allowed. Applicants and opposite party no.2 filed compromise deed before the trial court. Trial Court by order dated 29.09.2025 rejected the compromise application of both the parties. The memorandum of agreement between the parties has been filed as Annexure 11 to the application.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the opposite party no.2 does not dispute

the correctness of the facts.

5. Accordingly, it is provided that the parties shall appear before the court below alongwith a certified copy of this order and photocopy of the compromise deed for verification of the parties within a period of six weeks. The trial court is directed to verify the parties and thereafter, the court shall transmit the verification report to this Court within a period of two weeks.

6. List after eight weeks.

7. Till then no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants in Case No.65596 of 2023 (State vs. Devesh Panchal and others) arising out of Case Crime No.0101 of 2022, under sections 498A, 323, 406, 506 I.P.C. & Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act, Police Station Mahila Thana, District Ghaziabad, pending before the court of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/F.T.C.-1 (Crime against Women), Ghaziabad.
