1. This writ petition has been filed for quashing of the First Information Report dated 26.10.2025 giving rise to Case Crime No. 231 of 2025 under sections 3(1) of U.P. Gangster and Anti Social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986 Police Station Nawabganj, District - Central (Commissionerate Kanpur Nagar). The petitioner has also prayed that he be not arrested in pursuance of the impugned FIR.

2. Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner had been implicated falsely under the Gangsters Act only on the basis of such cases which were absolutely inconsequential. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that there was no due discussion before preparing the gang chart and before the lodging of the impugned FIR. It is further submitted that there was no application of mind. Learned counsel for the petitioner, therefore, submits that there was complete violation of Rules 5(3)(a), 16 and 17 of the U.P. Gangster and Anti-Social Activities (Prevention) Rules, 2021.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Learned AGA appearing for the respondents may file counter affidavit within a period of three weeks. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter.

5. List thereafter.

6. Till the next date of listing or till the submission of police report,

whichever is earlier, the petitioner shall not be arrested subject to his cooperation in the investigation. In the event, the petitioner does not cooperate in the investigation, the police will be at liberty to move this Court..
