1. Heard learned counsel for the appellants and Sri K.K.Gupta, learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. None has appeared for the respondent, even though a mention slip has also been served upon him.
3. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that the parties are willing to settle the matter through compromise. Therefore, the matter should be referred to mediation Centre for settlement of the dispute.
4. The appellants are directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 15,000/- by way of demand draft / pay order in the name of Registrar General A/c, Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre within a period of two weeks from today. The amount of Rs. 10,000/- shall be payable to the respondent no. 2 on her appearance before Mediation Centre and Rs.5,000/- shall be retained by the Mediation Centre towards cost of mediation centre.
5. Put up as fresh on 21.4.2026 along with report of Mediation Centre.
6. Till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Special Criminal Case No. 338 of 2022 (Smt. Khushi Katheriya @ Muskan vs. Raj Yadav and others), under Sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 IPC and Section 3/4 D.P. Act and Section 3(2)(va) SC/ST Act, P.S. Naubasta, District Kanpur Nagar, shall remain stayed.
