HON'BLE AVNISH SAXENA, J.

1. Sri Devesh Kumar Shukla, learned counsel appears for the applicant and submits that the accused-applicant is relative of informant and victim. [The F.I.R. of enticement has been lodged by the father of the victim against accused. The F.I.R. was lodged due to misconception. There is compromise entered into between the parties, which is annexed at page no.51 of the application, wherein the entire prosecution case has been denied. Hence, he seeks intervention of this Court to quash the charge-sheet and entire proceedings of the case as the parties have already buried their grievance.

2. Learned A.G.A. is present for State-opposite party no.1.

3. Sri Mahesh Kumar Kuntal, learned counsel appears for opposite party no.2 and submits that there is compromise entered into between the parties who are related to each other. Both the applicant and the victim have separately married and the informant does not want to continue with the matter. He has admitted the factum of compromise between the parties.

4. None appears for opposite party nos. 4 and 5.

5. Issue notice to opposite party no.3 returnable at an early date.

6. List this case on 05.02.2026 in top ten cases.

7. Meanwhile, the parties may exchange the affidavits.

8. The parties may appear before the trial court and file the compromise entered into between the parties, which shall be verified by the trial court.

The trial court may return the certified copy of compromise, keeping the original in the record, to this Court at an early date.

9. Considering the compromise entered into between the parties, further proceedings in Criminal Case No.124 of 2019 (State Versus Akash) arising out of Case Crime No.171 of 2012 under Sections 366, 363, 376, 506 I.P.C.and 3/4 of POCSO Act, 2012 Police Station Tappal, District Aligarh, pending in the court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Court No.3, (Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act, 2012), Aligarh is stayed.
